Itinerary

Thursday 8 March 2018	We will meet you at the Auckland International Airport check-in at 4.30am for our early flight to Melbourne at 6.30am. On arrival into Melbourne we will be met and transferred to the beautiful Langham Hotel for the next 4 nights. As our rooms will not be ready until the afternoon, we can leave our luggage at the hotel and go off to the most popular café in Melbourne and mix in with the locals at Brother Baba Budan on Little Burke Street. From there we could work out how the city tram system operates and take a tram out to St Kilda to ride the historic Great Scenic Roller Coaster. Or, check out the Spa Menu at the hotel later in the day for some R & R. Consider the Colonial Tramcar for dinner this evening or the iconic Corner Hotel in Richmond for some live music.
Friday 9 March 2018	Enjoy breakfast, before planning how to spend the rest of the day in this amazing city. You could hit the streets of Melbourne and soak up the atmosphere or join the Yarra Valley Winery Tour, which includes return transfers from the hotel, lunch and a visit to four or five of the regions wineries. This is a full day tour departing the hotel at 9.30am and arriving back at the hotel at 5.00pm. Head over to the Plaza at the Royal Exhibition Centre in Carlton from 5.30pm where there are loads of fun things to see and do, relax in the Festival Bar or visit the Priceline Beauty Pop-Up.
Saturday 10 March 2018	Following breakfast today you can head back to the Plaza at the Royal Exhibition Centre for more fashion exhibitions. We will meet early in the evening (time to be confirmed) for our fabulous Premium Runway Experience. The first Show is at 7.30pm and the second starts at 9.00pm. We will be seated close to the front to enjoy the shows and have full access to the Fashion Lounge for Canapes, beverages and entertainment. *The full festival schedule is yet to be finalised.
Sunday 11 March 2018	Following breakfast today you might like to catch up with what's happening in Federation Square, take a stroll along the Yarra River and grab a beer at the Arbory, a massive outdoor eatery and Melbourne's longest bar. Visit ArtVo at Docklands or fossick through the Melbourne Markets. Or simply pack in that last minute shopping.
