



TAURANGA – AUCKLAND

16th March (D)

Friday

From Pago, Pago, cross the date line, arriving in Vava'u, Tonga the following morning.

Vava'u is the island group of one large island and 40 smaller ones in Tonga. It is part of Vava'u District which includes several other individual islands.

Nuku'alofa is the capital, chief port and largest city of Tonga. The city is located on the coast of Tongatapu island. It is the commercial, transport and social centre of Tonga. Tourist attractions include; the Royal Palace, bustling markets and local shops.
