

PORT HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE

Tauranga, its name, fittingly enough, means "resting place for canoes", as this was the landing place of some of the first Maoris to arrive in New Zealand. Napier, with its pleasant climate and famous Art Deco architecture, is a charming seaside resort and is the main city and port of the Hawkes Bay province. Wellington nestled between a magnificent harbour and a natural amphitheatre of forest-clad hills, combines cultural sophistication, with great urban experiences - enjoy Te Papa, a flourishing arts scene, and exceptional dining and shopping. **Picton** at the head of the Queen Charlotte Sound will reveal some classic New Zealand scenery and access to the Marlborough wine country, outdoor activities such as kayaking, fishing, trekking and cycling. Akaroa the port for Christchurch is a quaint seaside town. It is nestled in the heart of an ancient volcano with a distinct French flavour due to French Whaling as well as a rich Maori and British Heritage. Kaikoura is famous for whale and dolphin watching, the large Southern Fur Seals found nearby, and many seabirds - albatross, petrels and shearwaters. New Zealand's own World Heritage site is **Milford Sound** – judged as one of the world's top travel destinations, and acclaimed as New Zealand's most famous tourist destination. Few New Zealanders have visited our third island in the south - Stewart Island The island is only about four percent inhabited, and is an unspoiled piece of primeval New Zealand. In the north Russell (Bay of Islands) holds a premier position in the nation's history, along with nearby Waitangi where the Maori chieftains signed a treaty in 1840 with the British Crown. Called the "hellhole of the Pacific" -- a nearly lawless outpost for whalers, sailors and ambitious traders flooding the new imperial frontier. Sailing out into the Pacific ocean, Norfolk Island beckons - you will enjoy the fantastic service and onboard experience with sailing days enroute to Kingston. Inhabited as early as 400 AD, with a checkered history as a penal colony and colonised by the families of Bounty mutineers who emigrated from remote Pitcairn Island in 1856. Kingston, and the nearby Arthurs Vale area, have UNESCO World Heritage Status.
