5 Sep 2017	Travel Napier to Toronto Today we travel from Napier to Toronto in Canada, where a local guide will meet us and assist with our transfer to the hotel. Accommodation: 3 nights Intercontinental Toronto Yorkville Hotel
Sep 2017	Toronto (B) After a late leisurely breakfast we will depart on a morning sightseeing tour of Toronto. Explore the city and visit the Casa Loma, a Gothic Revival style castle and gardens in downtown Toronto. A cherished landmark and one of the largest private residential structures in Canada. It includes 98 rooms, 1,800 bottle wine cellar, 10,000 volume libraries and an 800 foot underground tunnel system that leads to its stables. Entrance fee to Casa Loma is included. Return to hotel for remainder of day at leisure.
Sep 2017	Niagara Falls (B) Today we transfer in our private coach to Niagara Falls. On arrival at the Falls we have the day at leisure to explore the area using the Niagara Falls Wonder Pass. This includes the Journey behind the Falls, Niagara's Fury, and the butterfly conservatory. Return to Toronto at end of the day.
Sep 2017	Toronto - Quebec (B) Today transfer to Toronto Airport for our flight to Quebec City. On arrival at Quebec Airport we will be transferred to our hotel with the remainder of day at leisure. Accommodation: 1 night Hotel Port Royal
0 Sep 2017	Toronto - Quebec (BD) This morning after checking out of our hotel with our luggage, we take a private coach on a Full Day City Sightseeing Tour, with private guide. We'll visit the Montmorency Falls, and take the Cable Car to view the falls from the top. We'll visit the Basilica of Notre-Dame (the oldest Christian Parish north of Mexico). Included in the tour is a visit to La Citadelle de Quebec. Our tour ends at the Port where we board ms Zuiderdam.

2 Sep 2017	Cruising the Gulf of St. Lawrence Canada (BLD)
3 Sep 2017	Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island Canada (BLD) Walk the cobblestones of Victoria Row, see the house

that inspired "Anne of Green Gables," or explore the

wild shore of Prince Edward Island National Park.

Date Itinerary 24 Sep 2017 Sydney, Nova Scotia Canada (BLD) Along miles of rugged coastline see highland villages, explore the scenic Cabot Trail, sail golden inland seas and inspect the Fortress of Louisbourg. 25 Sep 2017 Halifax, Nova Scotia Canada (BLD) Discover the weatherbeaten landscape of Nova Scotia's south shore including the German village of Lunenburg – a UNESCO World Heritage Site. 26 Sep 2017 Bar Harbour, Maine USA (BLD) The raw coastal scenery attracted Hudson River School painters in the 1840s, and their art in turn lured visitors to the area. Walk the glittering streets of town, relax on the Village Green, or climb Cadillac Mountain. 27 Sep 2017 Boston, Massachusetts USA (BLD) Stroll along Boston's Freedom Trail to get a sense of the Revolutionary struggle that changed America's destiny. 28 Sep 2017 At Sea (BLD) 29 Sep 2017 Newport, Rhode Island USA (BLD) Stroll along the Cliff Walk of this yachting town and see some of the grandest mansions in America. 30 Sep 2017 New York (B) Welcome to New York! We will be met at the cruise terminal by a local guide and continue for a half day city "orientation" tour. Including a Round Trip Cruise to Liberty and Ellis Islands from Battery Park, the Statue of Liberty National Park, entrance to the Ellis Island Museum and an Audio Tour 9/11 Memorial Visit. At the end of the tour we continue to our hotel for check in. Accommodation: 4 nights Shelbourne NY 01-03 Oct New York (B)

Then travel through U Street, once known as "Black Broadway", DuPont Circle, Adams Morgan, Capitol Hill, and the notable Georgetown, a historic and affluent section of the city.

07 Oct 2017

Washington DC - New Orleans (B)

Today we will be transferred to the airport for our flight to New Orleans and on arrival we will be met and transferred to our hotel.

New Orleans (B)

Today we enjoy a fully guided city tour with private guide and coach, including entrance to the Laura Plantation on the River Road at Vacherie, and Cemetery Tour. On conclusion of the tour, the rest of the day is free.

09 Oct 2017

New Orleans & Cruising (BD)

This afternoon we board the American Duchess and wave au revoir to New Orleans as we set off on an incredible adventure up the Mighty Mississippi! Created from a 1995 hull it has been completely reconstructed to become one of the most luxurious river cruising vessels in the country.

10 Oct 2017

Nottoway (BLD)

Nottoway is the South's largest, most glorious remaining Antebellum mansion with a rich history dating back to 1859. In a fabulous location along the great River Road overlooking the grand Mississippi River, this "White Castle" of the South transports visitors back to an era of glory and grandeur. Set amongst a natural backdrop of vibrant gardens and 200 year old oak trees, Nottoway Plantation captivates all with a brilliant blend of true Southern hospitality, history and mystery.

11 Oct 2017

St. Francisville (BLD)

Established in 1809, St. Francisville is the oldest town in the Florida Parishes. Below where St. Francisville is currently located, was a settlement called Bayou Sara in the 1790s. When this settlement was destroyed by flooding and fires, many of the structures and artefacts were hauled up the bluff into St. Francisville, where they are still standing. The town is referred to as "two miles long and two yards wide," but that definitely doesn't mean they have nothing to offer! Stop in at one of the unique shops, historical homes, beautiful churches, or breathtaking parks and you will agree with that! Spanish moss trees grow throughout the town, which creates a beautiful southern comfort to the atmosphere.

12 Oct 2017

Natchez (BLD)

This charming river town was first inhabited by Natchez Indians and French explorers who shared the land. It was founded in 1716, making it the oldest city on the Mississippi. The city is known for its elegance, hospitality, and impressive preservation of history – found on every street corner throughout Natchez. Guests enjoy the unique shops, restaurants, museums and historical homes located, all of which contribute to Hugh Bayless' book, "The 100 Best Towns in America."

13 Oct 2017

Vicksburg (BLD)

Vicksburg perfectly blends Southern culture and heritage with exciting modern-day attractions. Described as the "Key to the South" by Abraham Lincoln, this southern town carries a history unlike any other Civil War city. Vicksburg was founded in 1811 and grew as a vital river port city. It was a major component to the Civil War and carries much of the history within the town. Today, Vicksburg is a popular spot for tourists to learn about the battles of the city, taste the cuisine, visit the many museums and pick out the perfect souvenir.

14 Oct 2017

Greenville (BLD)

Greenville is at the very heart and soul of Mississippi Delta. Located on the banks of Lake Fergusson, Greenville is a short drive to Indianola, the birthplace of B.B. King and many other blues singers, so naturally Greenville has its fair share of Blues integrated into its culture. Many authors and writers were born or reside in this small town; local legend says that the Greenville water grows writers. The author of the Muppets actually got started here along with a long list of other impressive, renowned writers. The town is also known for their gardening, which they were recognised for growing the largest carpet plant in the nation; and museums of which the town has one for practically everything! This beautiful town is sure to win your heart with its southern charm and soul!

15 Oct 2017

Leisurely River Cruising (BLD)

There is always plenty to do between dawn and dusk on the river and today is the perfect day to enjoy the many public spaces and activities that are available to you onboard. Gaze at the beautiful landscapes and small river towns as you mingle with fellow guests and discuss the unique aspects of river life. If you fancy a moment for yourself, retreat to the Gallery adorned with ornate bookcases stocked with an imaginative selection of reading material. Take hold of a literary classic, curl up on a plush chair in a cosy corner and relish every moment of serenity. The fitness facility, business centre, movie theatre and grand lobby offer other options for a day on the river.
